

**Parks, Recreation and Forestry Committee Meeting**  
**May 12, 2017, 9:30 am**

**Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 9:31 am by Committee Chair Pete Anzia

**Roll Call of Officers:** Members present were committee chair Pete Anzia, and trustee Clem Gottsacker and Dale Pfeifer. Also in attendance were Village Clerk Julie Lesar, and DPW Superintendent, Dan Birenbaum. Others in attendance: Pat Wester, Residents, Fred and Cricket Krier, and Jim Stehlik.

**Open Meeting Law Compliance Check:** This meeting is in compliance with the Open Meetings Law of the State of Wisconsin.

**Pledge to Flag, Moment of Silence:** All in attendance stood for the Pledge of Allegiance and moment of silence.

**5. Approval of Minutes:**

- a. Parks, Recreation and Forestry Committee Meeting October 26, 2016** – Motion was made by Gottsacker to approve minutes from October 26, 2016, seconded by Pfeifer. Ayes – Anzia, Gottsacker; and Pfeifer; Noes – none; Abstain – none. Motion carried

**6. Agenda Items:**

- a. Discuss providing Pickle Ball Courts in the Village:** Village resident, Fred Krier explained the game of pickle ball and the benefits it can provide to the community. Wester added that he has seen courts in other communities. One pickle ball court is painted in the center of an existing tennis court so that the area has double use. Birenbaum explained that budgeted maintenance is currently being completed on the tennis courts. The fence is being replaced; the courts are being resealed and repainted. He added that the DPW would be able to paint the lines for a pickle ball court on one of the tennis courts. Krier asked about the possibility of placing a screen or fence in-between the existing tennis courts. Birenbaum offered to get a price for a divider fence. Anzia made a motion to have the DPW paint one pickle ball court on one of the existing tennis courts. Motion was seconded by Gottsacker. Ayes – Anzia, Gottsacker; and Pfeifer; Noes – none; Abstain – none. Motion carried.
- b. Discuss posting of “No Dogs Allowed” signs in Village Parks:** The current postings in the Village’s parks were reviewed. Heritage Park and Bares Park currently do not have postings. It is a Village ordinance that no dogs are allowed in Village parks with the exception of Pepi’s Playground. Resident Jim Stehlik stated concerns regarding having dogs running loose at the Village’s parks. Birenbaum added that some of the signs were temporarily taken down because of maintenance or construction being completed. Anzia requested the Village DPW to post signs at the Village’s Parks where no dogs are allowed.
- c. Review of Budget:** the committee reviewed the budget.
- d. Adjourn:** Motion to adjourn at 10:10 am was made by Gottsacker, seconded by Pfeifer. Ayes – Anzia, Gottsacker, and Pfeifer; Noes – none; Abstain – none. Motion carried.
